## VIOLENCE AT CASEMATES

Following recent incidents of violence at Casemates, what action does Government intend to take to prevent a recurrence of such incidents?

#### ANSWER

Without proper specificity as to the incidents in question it is not possible to determine what incidents the Honourable Member is talking about. The period between April and June 2009 has already seen a decrease in offences being detected or reported to the police at Casemates Square. The area is well policed by the RGP particularly on Friday and Saturday or during the course of any staging of events. The RGP also have a zero tolerance policy on violence and between April 2008 to March 2009 there were a total of 29 arrests in the area.
