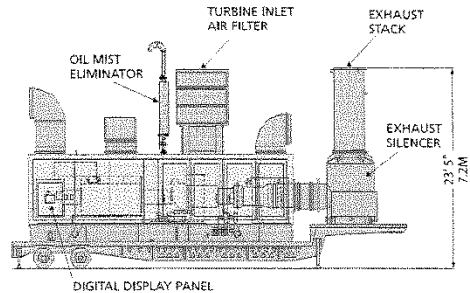
TYPICAL DIMENSIONS



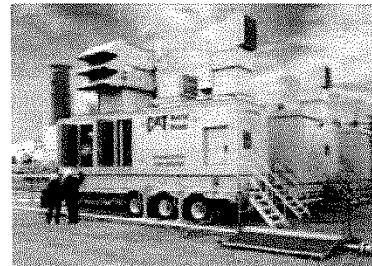
Installation Plan View
