## THE HON P R CARUANA

Will the Chief Minister say whether the Government's decision in relation to fishing in Gibraltar territorial waters by Spanish and other fishermen will be made only on environmental and or fish stock conservation grounds and, if not, what other grounds or considerations will be accommodated in the Government's position?

# ANSWER

The two main issues for the Government are (a) the need to re-establish the privacy of the Rule of Law, which the 1999 "Fishing Agreement" was clearly contrary to; and (b) environmental sustainability of any activity. The HMGoG will also have regard to such other matters as it may consider relevant.

Will the Chief Minister table in Parliament a copy of the recent agreement between the Government and the Ministry of Defence relating to the attendance at Government schools by the children of MOD personnel residing in Gibraltar?

# ANSWER

HMGoG has no objection to tabling the agreement in Parliament. Whilst we await a response from the MoD on its attitude to such tabling, a copy of the said agreement is provided herewith on a confidential basis for the Leader of the Opposition to have an opportunity to see the terms of it.

# THE HON P R CARUANA

Will the Chief Minister provide a list of all the reasons why it was not possible to commence departure operations at the new air terminal during May 2012?

# ANSWER

The main reasons why it was not possible to commence departure operations at the new Air Terminal during May 2012 is as follows:-

- There was no fire wall installed which meant that the building could not communicate with the outside world via the internet (no email, no secure airline host connections).
- The Access Control System had not been finalised or fully configured.
- The CCTV System had not been finalised or fully configured.
- The Building Management System had not been finalised or fully configured (this system controls all ventilation, extraction, lighting, heating and cooling for the terminal).
- The Common User Terminal Equipment (CUTE) was not fully functional due to configuration issues (CUTE is the communication system used for passenger and baggage handling).
- The Wireless Local Area Network (WLAN) had not been completed.
- The majority of items on the extensive snagging list had not yet been completed.

All of this made it impossible to guarantee the security of the building in a manner which would satisfy those responsible for airline security.

Will the Chief Minister say whether it is the policy of the Government that Gibraltar should be able to participate in the Olympic Games in its own right, as other UK Overseas Territories do, and that Gibraltarians should thus participate in representation of Gibraltar? If so, can the Chief Minister say what is the current position regarding Gibraltar Olympic Committee's quest for recognition by the International Olympic Committee?

# <u>ANSWER</u>

The answer to the first part of the question is "yes". The answer to the second part of the question is as provided for in answer to Oral Question 714 of 2012.

Will the Chief Minister provide an update on the EU Commission's investigation into Gibraltar's current Income Tax Act, and say who is representing and advising the Government in that regard, and will he further say what is the position of HMG in the UK on the matter?

#### ANSWER

The position is that on 2 July 2012 the EU Commission wrote to HMG in the UK informing that it had received a State aid Complaint from Spain, concerning Gibraltar's Income Tax Act 2010. The Commission has asked a series of questions in order to assess whether it is necessary to open a formal investigation procedure. The Government is being advised by its Chief Legal Advisor Michael Llamas QC, Hassans and Counsels in Brussels. The position of HMG in the UK is of full support for HMG of Gibraltar.

Will the Chief Minister say what contingency plans the Government has in place to negate any attempt by Spain to usurp jurisdiction and interfere with our exclusive jurisdiction in BGTW in relation to such matters as environmental protection and bunkering?

#### **ANSWER**

It would not be appropriate to provide this information in public at this stage. I am happy to discuss these issues with the Hon Leader of the Opposition in private.

Will the Chief Minister say in what regard GBC will be more independent of the Government than hitherto, and what oversight role Ministers have now which he believes will be reduced?

#### ANSWER

The GBC will be much more independent from Government if it is entirely selfsufficient and not dependent on Government for a subvention. The model until now has been that the Board of GBC regulated all matters relating to GBC and was appointed by the Governor in effect on the advice of the Chief Minister. Now, the broadcasting Bill will allow for independent regulation of all broadcasters by the Gibraltar Regulatory Authority and the appointment of the Board will be by the Chief Minister in consultation with the Leader of the Opposition and thereafter with the Governor given his Constitutional responsibilities for internal security.

Will the Chief Minister say whether the contracts entered into with UK private sector companies in relation to broadcasting gives them (i) any editorial or creative role in the content of GBC programmes (ii) any other role in or in relation to GBC other than provision of broadcasting network infrastructure? And will the Chief Minister lay a copy of those agreements in Parliament?

#### ANSWER

There are as yet no finalised contracts of the type referred to in the question. In any event, the proposed joint venture or the contracts to establish the digital network (which are with the GRA and not with GBC) provide absolutely no editorial or creative role in the content of GBC programmes or any other role in relation to GBC.

Will the Chief Minister say whether HMG in the UK fully supports and endorses, as the Gibraltar Opposition does, the Gibraltar Government's position in relation to Spanish designation of our waters for EU environmental purposes, that the Gibraltar Government will never allow these waters to be treated by anyone other than as of exclusively British Sovereignty and Gibraltar jurisdiction? And if so, can he say whether HMG in the UK have given GOG any assurances that they will take effective practical action to counteract any behaviour by Spain to the contrary?

# ANSWER

The answer to both questions is "yes".

#### THE HON P R CARUANA

Will the Chief Minister say whether the Government considers that the EU now adopting positions in relation to BGTW which are inconsistent with its own historical treatment of them as part of the EU by virtue of the UK's membership, is in fact "interfering in a territorial dispute" contrary to what they assert they are unable to do?

#### ANSWER

The view of HMGoG is that:

- (i) Spain should not have designated;
- (ii) The UK should have noticed and earlier challenged the designation and
- (iii) The EU should not have accepted, the designation of part of BGTW as an area of a Spanish SCI. The recent decision of the ECJ is not credible for reasons as much related to the fact that the jurisdiction over BGTW is clear and contrary to the Spanish designation as for the composition of the Chamber of the Court that dealt with it.

Will the Chief Minister say what is the current position in relation to the Eastside project and whether the Government has any intention of withdrawing all or any part of the site from the developers?

# **ANSWER**

HMGOG is discussing how best to progress the Eastside Project with the developers of the site.
