A total of 1,024 water samples have been taken and analysed during the period 2013/14. Sampling works are carried out every month by means of the Department of the Environment's monitoring and surveillance programmes. The following is a summary of the main water quality monitoring programmes currently managed by the department:

1. Coastal Water Monitoring – monitoring and sampling of Gibraltar's coastal waters is carried out in compliance with the Water Framework Directive (WFD) and the Marine Strategy Framework Directive (MSFD). The programme is carried out on a monthly basis by the department's technical officers. The programme consists of collecting water samples from specific monitoring sites which then undergo laboratory analysis in the UK. Additionally, a number of in-situ measurements are taken at each site. Water quality parameters that are monitored include physico-chemical quality elements, chemical elements and biological quality elements (e.g. phytoplankton). Sampling is carried out approximately 100m from the shore in a total of 6 core sites which include:

- Eastern Beach (South)
- Catalan Bay (North)
- Sandy Bay
- Camp Bay
- Gibraltar Harbour
- Western side of the runway (North West)

The results of the water samples analysed during 2013/14 indicate that the Gibraltar Coastal Waters are generally of good status.

2. Groundwater Monitoring – The department routinely monitors a number of groundwater wells located in both the northern isthmus aquifer and southern bedrock aquifer. Monitoring and sampling of these wells is carried out in compliance with the WFD. The monitoring consists of taking measurements of the groundwater's physical parameters every month and collecting water samples from each well on a quarterly basis. Samples are currently taken from 5 sites which include:

Following the recent incident at Waterport Power Station the GEA has had no choice but to operate both the South District Power Station and GMES for longer periods than had been the case in the preceding months.

In doing so, the GEA has temporarily reverted back to the previous operating regime that has been in place since both power stations were in existence including the 16 years the GSD were in power, therefore the levels of exhaust and noise emissions have regrettably also reverted to the similar levels as were present before. This operating regime is a temporary solution until the installation of the new engines is completed; subject to power flows, the intention is then to revert to reduced operating hours in the South District power stations.

Notwithstanding this, there was one incident on the 30<sup>th</sup> April in which operators at the South District Power Station carried out a load test to No. 3 generating set after completing a major overhaul to the engine. This testing caused excessive white smoke to emanate from the engine exhaust. The operators attributed the problem to low lube oil pressure and excessive loss of oil through the No. 5 bearing shell, due to the fitting of an incorrectly sized bearing. This incident is totally unrelated to the Waterport fire incident or to the change in operational regime in the South District.

During this period, the Environmental Agency received two complaints of black smoke emanating from the South District Power Station – on the 24<sup>th</sup> April and the 12<sup>th</sup> May. On both occasions the emissions of smoke was attributed to the start-up of generators which is normal for this operation.
