Can the Government please provide a breakdown of where and how all the monies deposited in the Gibraltar Savings Bank have been invested and the rate of return on each of these investments as at 31 May 2021?

ANSWER

The average yield in respect of the different categories of investment vehicles held by the Savings Bank Fund for the month in question are as follows:-

On-call accounts with the Lloyds Bank, the Bank of New York, Bank of England and Gibraltar Banks had an average yield of around 0.2%. The Gibraltar Banks were Barclays Bank, National Westminster Bank, Trusted Novus Bank, Gibraltar International Bank, Kleinwort Hambros Bank and MoneyCorp Bank.

Floating Rates Notes and other Fixed Interest Notes quoted on the London Stock Exchange had an average yield of around 0.7%. On average how long does it take authorities to repatriate anyone entering Gibraltar without valid papers or documents?

ANSWER

Each case dealt with is different, and the following factors will determine the length of time taken to repatriate someone. This can range from 24hrs in simple cases to 6-8 months in complex cases.

- a) The nationality of the individual;
- b) Whether or not the individual is in possession of any identity/travel documents;
- c) Whether or not the individual cooperates with the RGP in facilitating identity verification;
- d) Each country (through its embassies/consulates) has different systems for processing requests to verify the identity of persons claiming to originate from said country, as well as differing procedures governing the issue of emergency travel documents prior to authorising said individual's return to his/her country of origin, usually under RGP escort; and
- e) The transport links to the country of origin, in some cases transiting third countries, for which permissions must be obtained.

In the case of Morocco, the average repatriation time prior to the COVID-19 pandemic stood at 1 month for non-complex cases:

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, transportation links between Gibraltar and Morocco have temporarily been suspended.

Her Majesty's Government of Gibraltar, together with the Foreign, Commonwealth & Development Office and The Moroccan Community Association, are presently lobbying the Moroccan Government to resume these links.
