“THIS HOUSE


NOTES that we must tackle the serious skills deficit and the real need for the introduction of high quality apprenticeships to meet the needs of existing and emerging business.

Acknowledges the statement by Unite the Union on 27th October 2015 for the introduction of advanced apprenticeships to counteract the skills cliff edge and the growth in sub-standard apprenticeship provision in Gibraltar.

Acknowledges the statement by the Chamber of Commerce during the 2015 General Election Campaign calling on the Government to give assistance to private sector business which provides apprenticeship or other forms of vocational training.

Acknowledges the statement presented to all Honourable Members of the House on 22 September 2016 by concerned members of our community calling for the introduction of high quality apprenticeships for young people.

AND calls on the Government to introduce high quality apprenticeships in traditional crafts and trades as well creation of a modern apprenticeship programme for the training of skills in technology and allied services.
