The Hon D A Feetham has given notice on 12th October 2016 that he proposes to move the following motion at the next meeting of Parliament:


“THIS HOUSE

NOTES that there are no overriding advantages for single-sex schools on educational grounds.

Acknowledges that there is a compelling case for the view that co-education provides a more realistic way of educating and training young people to take their places naturally in the wider community of men and women.

Acknowledges that education and ways to improve it, must always remain at the top of the political agenda in this community and debate on these issues is important.

AND calls on the Government to generate that debate by undertaking a consultation exercise with teachers, the unions, parents, students and other stakeholders to determine the views of the community on this issue.”
