



**NOTICE OF MOTION**

The Hon R M Clinton has given notice on 8<sup>th</sup> June 2016 that he proposes to move the following motion at the next meeting of Parliament:

“This House notes the contents of the Principal Auditors report on the audit of the public accounts of Gibraltar for the year 31 March 2014 and calls on the Government to address his findings.

This House furthermore Resolves that a standing committee be created to be designated as the “Public Accounts Committee” for the examination of the Accounts showing the appropriation of sums granted by Parliament to meet the Public Expenditure, to consist of four members, two Government ministers and two Opposition members, who shall be nominated at the commencement of every Session, and of whom two shall be a quorum with the Chair to be held by the Opposition.”
