IVORY ACT 2019

IVORY ACT (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 40 and 41 of the Ivory Act 2019, the Minister has made these Regulations.

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Ivory Act (Amendment) Regulations 2023.

Commencement.

2. These Regulations come into operation on the day of publication.

Amendment to the Ivory Act 2019.

3.(1) The Ivory Act 2019 is amended in accordance with the provisions of this regulation.

(2) Section 40(1) is substituted in its entirety for —

“40. (1) In this Act (apart from this section) “ivory” means ivory from the tusk or tooth of —

- (a) an elephant;
- (b) a common hippopotamus (*Hippopotamus amphibius*);
- (c) a killer whale, also known as orca (*Orcinus orca*);
- (d) a narwhal (*Monodon monoceros*);
- (e) a sperm whale (*Physeter macrocephalus*); and
- (f) a walrus (*Odobenus rosmarus*).”.

(3) Section 40(4) is deleted in its entirety.
