POSTAL VOTING (PROCEDURE) RULES

ELECTION TO THE PARLIAMENT TO BE HELD ON THE 4th JULY 2013

APPLICATION TO BE REGISTERED AS A POSTAL VOTER

It is notified for general information that, under the Postal Voting (Procedure) Rules, facilities are available to electors who, owing to their temporary absence from Gibraltar on the day of the poll, are unable to go in person to the polling station, to apply to the Returning Officer to be registered in the List of Postal Voters.

Applications should be made in writing in a special form which is obtainable from the Returning Officer at Parliament House.

Applications to be treated as a postal voter should be submitted to the Returning Officer at Parliament House **AS SOON AS POSSIBLE** and **MUST** reach him **NOT LATER THAN NOON ON WEDNESDAY 26TH JUNE 2013**.

Once an application to vote in the above manner is accepted by the Returning Officer, the elector's name and address will be published in a list of postal voters and any such person will only be able to vote by post and **NOT** at any Polling Station.

Further information may be obtained from the Returning Officer at Parliament House.
