### POSTAL VOTING (PROCEDURE) RULES

ELECTION TO THE PARLIAMENT TO BE HELD ON THE 12<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 2023

#### APPLICATION TO BE REGISTERED AS A POSTAL VOTER

It is notified for general information that, under the Postal Voting (Procedure) Rules, facilities are available to electors to apply to the Returning Officer to be registered in the List of Postal Voters.

Applications should be made in writing in the prescribed form which is obtainable from the Returning Officer at Parliament House. Alternatively, the form can also be downloaded from the Parliament's website [www.parliament.gj](http://www.parliament.gj).

If you have registered for eGov services and you are on the Register of Electors you can apply to receive a postal vote using the link below: <https://parliament.egov.gj/ParlPostalVoteApp>

Applications to be treated as a postal voter should be submitted to the Returning Officer at Parliament House **AS SOON AS POSSIBLE** and **MUST** reach him **NOT LATER THAN NOON ON WEDNESDAY 4<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 2023**.

Once an application to vote in the above manner is accepted by the Returning Officer, the elector's name and address will be published in a list of postal voters and any such person will only be able to vote by post and **NOT** at any Polling Station.

Further information may be obtained from the Returning Officer at Parliament House.
