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Voting by Proxy

- Proxy voting means that if you are not able to cast your vote in person, you can have someone you trust cast your vote for you.
- You can use this form to apply to vote by proxy for one particular referendum only.
- Both you and your proxy must be registered and eligible to vote.
- A person can only be a proxy for close relatives and up to two people at the referendum.
- Close relatives are the spouse, civil partner, parent, grandparent, brother, sister, child or grandchild of the applicant.

How do I vote by Proxy?

- You must ask someone who is willing and capable to be your proxy to vote on your behalf.
- Fill in the proxy vote application form. You must give a reason why you want to vote by proxy, for example you may be abroad on holiday on Referendum Day.
- Make sure you complete all sections of the form and supply your date of birth and signature. You need to give your date of birth and signature on this application form. This information is needed to prevent fraud. If you are unable to sign this form, please contact the Referendum Administrator.
- Return your form to the Referendum Administrator, Parliament House, 156 Main Street, Gibraltar
- The deadline for changing or cancelling an existing proxy is 12 noon, on 18 June 2021. Please visit parliament.gi for more information about deadlines.
- If you are not already registered to vote, you must register before applying for a proxy vote. The deadline to register to vote is 6.00 pm, on 17 June 2021.

What happens after I return this form?

- Your proxy must go to your voting station to vote.
- Your proxy will be sent a proxy poll card, telling them where and when to vote on your behalf.
- You should let your proxy know how you want them to vote on your behalf, for example, your preferred outcome.
- If it turns out that you are able to go to the voting station on Referendum Day, you can vote in
 person as long as your proxy has not already done so.
